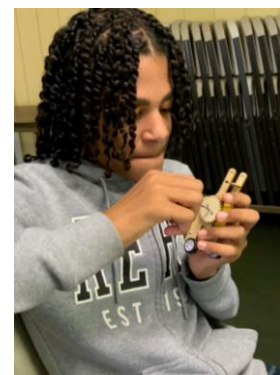

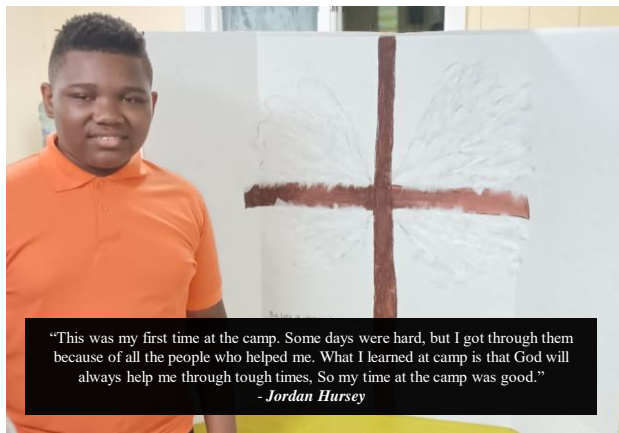
*“Grateful For the Opportunity to Serve”
